He is active in the field of postgraduate education in surgery (educational DVDs - Abdominal procedure on gynecological oncology, Easy learning hysterectomy), organizer of postgraduate meetings (International Videoworkshop on surgery in gynecological oncology - 2008, 2010, 2012), founder of the ESGO Task Force on Surgery in Gynecologic Oncology, chair of the Meeting committee of the European Society of Gynecologic Oncology (ESGO) and President Elect of the ESGO (2013 - 2015).

Membro della Society of Gynecologic Oncology (SGO), della American Society of Clinical Oncology e Honorary Fellow della American College of Surgery e dell'American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Antonio Pellicer, MD

Professor in Obstetrics and Gynecology since 1999 and Dean of the University of Valencia School of Medicine, Spain from 2006 until 2012. He is also Chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at 'La Fe University Hospital', Valencia, since 2009.

After obtaining his MD degree from the University of Valencia and establishing a distinguished academic career, Professor Pellicer founded the 'Instituto Valenciano de Infertilidad' ('IVI') in 1990, and his work in the field of fertility has led to the creation of many 'IVI' clinics both in Spain and internationally. He is also President of the 'IVI Foundation' for the Study of Reproduction and Director of 'Equipo IVI'.

Professor Pellicer has authored over 200 textbook chapters and more than 700 journal articles in national and international journals, and presented over 400 lectures in a congresses. He has been Co-Editor in Chief for the journal 'Fertility and Sterility' since 2011. Professor Pellicer has won many awards for his contributions to the field of reproductive health. He was awarded the Annual Meeting Prize Paper for the 'American Society for Reproductive Medicine' six times between 1987 and 2005; the XXV Society for Gynecological Investigation President's Award in 2002; the King Jaime I Prize in Clinical Medicine from the 'King Jaime I Foundation' in 2004; the Gold Medal of the Royal College of Physicians in Valencia in 2006; the Gold Medal of the City of Valencia in 2006; the Rotary Prize in 2007; and the Lilly Foundation Prize in 2008. He is Doctor Honoris Causa by the Politechnic University of Valencia in 2011.



Felice Petraglia, MD

Professor and Chairman of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Siena (Siena, Italy). Since 2004 he is an Adjunct Professor of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at University of Toronto (Toronto, Canada).

His major scientific interest is devoted to women's health. He has been a pioneer in the exploration of the role of neuroendocrine peptides and growth factors in placental-fetal unit, and is currently investigating the role of these molecules in the molecular mechanisms of endocrine-dependent reproductive disorders (endometriosis, uterine fibromata, PCOS). He is Fellow and Eundem of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG), Correspondent Member of the Pontifical Academy for Life (PAL). He is included as expert in Obstetrics and Gynecology in the Italian Drug Agency (AIFA) and in the group of expert of the Ministry of University.

He was President of the Society for Gynecologic Investigation (SGI) (2008-2009). He was member of the Executive Committee of the International Society of Gynecological Endocrinology (ISGE) (2000-2012), member in the Membership Committee of the Endocrine Society (2003-2006), member of the Scientific Committee of the European Association of Gynaecology and Obstetrics (1996-1999), of the Council of the European Board and College of Obstetrics and Gynecology (EBCOG, 2006-2010), member of the Executive Board of the International Federation of Gynecology

and Obstetrics (FIGO) (2009-2012), Deputy of the ESHRE Special Interest Group on Reproductive Endocrinology (2003-2007), President of the Italian Society of the Reproduction (SIrR) (2012). He is Editor-in-Chief of Human Reproductive Update (2013), he is member of the Editorial Board of Reproductive Sciences, Journal of Endometriosis, Journal of Endocrinological Investigation, Gynecological Endocrinology, Faculty 1000 Medicine. He was Associate Editor of Human Reproduction Update, member of the Editorial Board of the Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism (1995-1999), Placenta (1993-1998), the European Journal of Endocrinology (1996-2004). He has received recognition for his accomplishments, including an International Award "Arnaldo Bruno" from the Accademia dei Lincei (2001). Author or co-author of more than 550 peer reviewed papers in International Scientific Journals (Impact Factor total=1904 - Hirsch Index=57) and co-editor of 25 scientific volumes. He has been invited speaker at International Meetings (n=116); member of Scientific Board (n=25), Scientific Secretary (n=20) and President (n=13) of several International Meetings.



Jaime Prat, MD

MD from University of Madrid and trained in anatomic pathology at The New York Hospital Cornell Medical College. After completing a postdoctoral fellowship in Surgical Pathology at Memorial-Sloan Kettering Cancer Center also in New York City, he became a faculty member of the Harvard Medical School at the Massachusetts General Hospital, working under the leadership of Dr. Robert E. Scully for five years. During this time, he was a Junior Faculty Clinical Fellow of the American Cancer Society, studied the consequences of in utero exposure to diethylstilbestrol, and published several original papers on gynecologic cancers. He is a diplomat of the American Board of Pathology in Anatomic Pathology, a fellow the Royal College of Pathologists of Great Britain, and has been on faculty at the US and Canadian Academy of Pathology since 1977, lecturing at three short courses and the 2004 long course. He has also been a guest speaker at the 2001 Arthur Purdy Stout Society of Surgical Pathologists. Dr. Prat has served as Chairman of the Department of Pathology at Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau and Professor of Pathology at Autonomous University of Barcelona since 1986. For the last 20 years, he has lectured at many postgraduate courses and has been invited speaker at numerous national and international meetings. He is the author of over 250 publications and serves on multiple editorial boards. His research has focused on clinicopathologic features and molecular genetics of gynecological malignancies. Dr. Prat has been President of the European Board of Pathology (1999-2004), and President of the International Society of Gynecologic Pathologists (2007-2009). He is also member of the World Health Organization (WHO) Committee for Classification of Tumours of the Female Genital Tract, (IARC, Lyon France; 2002), and The International Federation of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (FIGO), Committee on Gynecologic Oncology (2008).

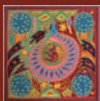
